課程描述 Course Description

This course introduces the principal genres and reading approaches of literature. Emphasis is placed on literary terminology, devices, structure, and interpretation. Upon completion, students should be able to analyze and respond to literature. The focus in this course is on reading, interpreting, and understanding the material. Each student will be evaluated mainly on the basis of participation in the weekly discussions of the required readings, and on the sequence of writing assignments in response to the readings. The comprehensive mind-term and final exams will consist of several brief essay compositions along with a short set of objective questions. An oral presentation on a writer not covered in class will complete the requirements for student evaluation.

Upon completion of this course, the student will be able to:

- 1. Define important literary terminology and apply it correctly in discussions, tests, and essays.
- 2. Define major characteristics of fiction, drama, and poetry.
- 3. Support interpretations about a given work of literature through the analysis of important words, lines, and passages.
- 4. Communicate effectively through writing, reading, and speaking.
- 5. Examine the arts/humanities and social behavioral sciences from cultural and historic perspectives.
- 6. Follow MLA conventions of parenthetical references for fiction, drama, and poetry.
- 7. Construct properly formatted MLA style essays designed to analyze important concepts within representative works

課程目標 Course Objectives

To inculcate the skills for reading, analyzing, interpreting and appreciating literary works. By close reading English prose, short stories, poems and dramas, to enable the explorations of the literary forms, basic structural elements, creative writing techniques, and comprehend the critical glossary, literary schools and contemporary reading strategies.
