課程描述 Course Description

This course is designed to help students understand various aspects of contemporary culture and cultivate their critical thinking. In this semester, we will study essays and some TED talk transcripts on topics such as generation recession, current global issues, Taiwan, food and business, carbon footprints, ethical dilemmas, fashion, consumer culture, relationships and family affairs, sexism and racism, and digital world. We will continue to read the selected essays and transcripts critically and discuss them cross-culturally. Students need to give two group presentations on the assigned essays and five one-minute presentations on the topics discussed in this semester to strengthen their critical thinking and presentation skills. Students are expected to come to each class prepared and participate vigorously in English in class discussions.
