An oral presentation on a writer not covered in class will complete the requirements for student evaluation

By close reading English prose, short stories, poems and dramas, to enable the explorations of the literary forms, basic structural elements, creative writing techniques, and comprehend the critical glossary, literary schools and contemporary reading strategies.
